One is not required to check Aadhaar, PAN before sex: HC

New Delhi: A person in a consensual relationship is not required to check an Aadhaar or a PAN card to verify his partner's date of birth before having sex, Delhi High Court has said, granting bail to a man in a case of suspected honeytrap.
The court also ordered the police chief to have a "detailed investigation" if the "victim" woman was a habitual offender who extorted money by lodging an FIR of rape against men.
"The person, who is in a consensual physical relationship with another person, is not required to judicially scrutinise the date of birth of the other person. He is not required to see Aadhaar card, PAN card and verify the date of birth from her school record before he enters into a physical relationship," Justice Jasmeet Singh said last week.

ek, while dealing with a case where the woman claimed she was a minor at the time of the crime and was first lured into consensual sex, then threatened and raped by the accused.
The court found several discrepancies in her version and also a money trail showing she had received Rs 50 lakh in her account from the accused over a period of nearly a year — the last payment made just a week before the FIR was registered and the stringent PCO Act was invoked against him.
The judge cited an earlier court order observing an increase in cases where innocent people were being honey-trapped and huge amounts of money were being extracted from them. "I am of the view that in the present case, there is much more than what meets the eye... I am, prima facie, of the view that this also seems to be a case of such incident," Justice Singh recorded in his order, directing the CP to "have a detailed investigation... if any such similar FIR has been registered by the prosecutrix against any other person in Delhi".
Appearing for the man, advocate Amit Chaddha highlighted that the woman had three different dates of birth. As per the Aadhaar card, her date of birth is January 1, 1998, but in her PAN card, it's 2004. When police verified, it found her date of birth to be of June 2005.
As per the Aadhaar card, "on the date of the alleged incident, the prosecutrix was supposed to be a major", the court pointed out. It asked police to investigate the card number and the date of issuance of the same and the supporting documents. The very fact that there is an Aadhaar card that shows date of birth as January 1, 1998 is enough for the accused to "form an opinion that he was not indulging in physical relationship with a minor", it added. While granting bail, the court also referred to the transfers of huge amounts in her favour from June 2021 to April 2022.

Apex court seeks response of UP govt on bail plea of journalist Siddique Kappan

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday issued notice to the Uttar Pradesh government on a bail plea of Kerala-based journalist Siddique Kappan who was arrested in October 2020 while on his way to Hathras where a Dalit woman had died after allegedly being gang-raped.
A bench comprising Chief Justice Uday Umesh Lalit and Justice S Ravindra Bhat posted his bail plea for final disposal on September 9. Senior advocate Kapil Sibal and lawyer Harish Beeran, appearing for Kappan, said the journalist is in jail since October, 2020 and has been accused of taking part in terrorist activities for being part of PFI (Popular Front of India) which is neither a terrorist outfit nor a

banned organisation.
"I have nothing to do with PFI. I am a journalist. I was once working with a media organisation which allegedly had some kind of connection with the PFI. I am not working with that organisation anymore," Sibal said.
He said like other journalists, Kappan was also going to Hathras. **TNN**

SC issues notice on stricter fine for black marketing

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday agreed to examine a plea seeking its direction to the Centre and states to invoke the stringent National Security Act against the persons involved in the act of hoarding, profiteering, adulteration and black marketing of essential goods like medicine which was witnessed during the Covid-19 pandemic.
The bench issued notice to the Centre and states seeking their response on a PIL which also sought that Section 31 of Criminal Procedure Code, should not apply to the offences for hoarding, profiteering, adulteration and black marketing and the sentence should be consecutive, not concurrent. **TNN**

Plea seeking Rafale deal docus dismissed

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday refused to entertain a petition urging it to summon relevant documents from a French investigative agency which claimed to have found evidence that bribes were allegedly paid in the Rs 59,000-crore Rafale deal to purchase 36 fighter jets.
Appearing before a bench

of Chief Justice U.L.Lalit and S Ravindra Bhat, petitioner advocate M.L.Sharma alleged that a French probe agency found involvement of middlemen in the deal and bribe was allegedly paid by Dassault. "If the French probe agency said 1 billion euros were paid as bribe then we need to see those papers and thus letters rogatory is needed," he submitted while pressing that the court should interfere to get those documents to find out the truth.
The bench, however, was not convinced with his submission and said it cannot pass such order while exercising power under Article 32 and dismissed the petition.

After a while Sharma again stood up and pleaded the court to allow him to withdraw the petition and grant his liberty to approach CBI to raise his grievances. Allowing him to withdraw the plea, the court said there was no need to grant him liberty to approach a probe agency, saying "No one is stopping you." **TNN**

Setalvad bypassed HC by seeking bail in SC, shouldn't get spl treatment: Guj to SC

New Delhi: The Gujarat government on Monday told the Supreme Court that activist Teesta Setalvad, arrested for allegedly fabricating evidence to ratchet up 2002 post-Godhra riots cases, should not be given any special treatment as she filed her bail plea bypassing the high court and that the constitutional mandate of equality should be applied to one and all.
The state also informed the court that it had found sufficient evidence against her and there was a political figure who was supporting the social activist in hatching conspiracy and fabricating evidence in 2002 riot cases. Raising questions on the very maintainability of her petition, the state in its affidavit said that Teesta had rightly approached the HC against the trial court order rejecting her bail plea but then she moved SC without waiting for the outcome of her plea in HC which posted the hearing for September 19.
"In the HC, dates are fixed as per the number of matters pending for consideration before it keeping bail applications of other accused citizens also in mind. It could not have been possible for the HC to give any special treatment to the petitioner over other accused who are similarly situated citizens," the affidavit said. The state government said all are equal before law and there is no reason for her to be allowed to bypass the remedy which is consciously selected by her.
"It is submitted that this would not only set a wrong precedent but would also be contrary to settled legal position," the affidavit said.

Justice Uday Umesh Lalit, who had paid with his judiciousness for granting bail to an accused arrested under the Maintenance of Internal Security Act (MISA) during the Emergency, stood watching the proceedings for a good 20 minutes, turning down offers to take a seat, then bowed before the CJJ and left the court.
Shortly after the Emergency was lifted, Justice U.R.Lalit shifted his practice to the SC in the early 1980s and built a lucrative career in criminal law, to be regarded as one of the leading lights in the field. CJJ Lalit, following his father's footsteps, entered the legal profession and within a decade of his practice in the SC, got recognition for his incisive legal mind in criminal law.
Finding senior advocate U.R.Lalit standing, a few senior advocates offered him a seat. But he refused, not wanting to miss even a second of the "first day, first show" of his son in the CJJ's seat. He kept standing at the corner of the front row keenly watching the proceedings.
It is common for relatives and family members to watch from the visitors' gallery, particularly on the first day of a Chief Justice in the court. As Umesh R.Lalit is a senior advocate practising in Supreme Court, he was in his robes and attended the proceedings from the front. Advocates led by Kapil Sibal and solicitor general Tushar Mehta wished the CJJ and assured all cooperation and assistance in court proceedings.
